Following God's Plan of Tithing Is:

- 1. A practice of gratitude
- 2. A practice of priority
- 3. A practice of faith



If Christians In The U.S. Were To Tithe (\$165 Billion would be available to help others):

- 1. \$25 billion could relieve global hunger, starvation, and deaths from preventable diseases in five years.
- 2. \$12 billion could eliminate illiteracy in five years.
- 3. \$15 billion could solve the world's water and sanitation issues, specifically at places in the world where 1 billion people live on less than \$1 per day.
- 4. \$1 billion could fully fund all overseas mission work so people can hear the Gospel and respond to Jesus.
- 5. \$100 \$110 billion would still be left over for additional ministry expansion (Relevant, 2021)

Tithe:	or 10%

All the believers were one in heart and mind. No one claimed that any of their possessions was their own, but they shared everything they had. With great power the apostles continued to testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And God's grace was so powerfully at work in them all that there were no needy persons among them. For from time to time those who owned land or houses sold them, brought the money from the sales and put it at the apostles' feet, and it was distributed to anyone who had need. (Acts 4:32-35)

Bottom Line: *Tithing is the training wheels for greater generosity.*
