Jesus Tells His Disciples:

- 1. One of His disciples sitting with Him at the table would betray Him**
- 2. The rest of the disciples would deny Him and abandon Him in His time of need**
- 3. He would have to leave them and that they could no longer follow Him at this time**

Simon Peter asked Him, “Lord, where are You going?” Jesus replied, “Where I am going, you cannot follow now, but you will follow later.” (John 13:36)

“Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in God; believe also in Me.” (John 14:1)

“Believe also in Me.”

Don’t let fear and uncertainty _____ you from still believing in Me, from trusting in Me, and from relying on Me.

“My Father’s house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with Me that you also may be where I am. You know the way to the place where I am going.” (John 14:2-4)

They [believers] will be His people, and God Himself will be with them and be their God. He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death’ or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away. He who was seated on the throne said, “I am making everything new!” (Revelation 21:3-5)

The more we think about Jesus, the more we look forward to _____.

For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal. (2 Corinthians 4:17-18)

“So how can we know the way?” (John 14:5)

“I am The Way and The Truth and The Life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.” (John 14:6)

Since Jesus says that He is The Truth, that means that He has to be exclusively The Truth.
