People mentioned in the letter to the Colossian church:

Scriptures referenced in sermon message: Colossians 1:13-14

- **-Paul:** Encountered the resurrected Christ and became a follower of Jesus. He planted churches all over Asia Minor and was imprisoned in Rome for his faith at the time when this letter was written.
- -**Epaphras:** Paul's friend who planted this church in Colossae. In visiting Paul, he lets Paul know about what was happening in the Colossian church and asks for Paul's help to make things right.
- **-Timothy:** Paul's mentee who accompanied Paul during his missionary journeys to plant churches around the region of Asia Minor.
